Role Summary: Hmong Home Health Care is hiring for a Home Care Advocacy and Policy Leader with experience influencing policy makers and legislative decision makers to advance key organizational home care initiatives in assigned states/regions. Depending on state assignments and location, some overnight travel expected (2-4 nights per month).

Role Description:

- Monitor and assess legislative action, state budget impacts, Medicaid policy, Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) policy, employment legislation/policy and any other related regulatory areas that effect HCBS services and/or create new opportunities in assigned cities/counties/states/region.
- Monitor key news sources, home care industry bulletins, Center for Medicare and Medicaid bulletins, and other home care/health care related articles/periodicals to track legislative/policy developments.
- Understand the key drivers that lead to sustainable/successful home care operations, and assess how key legislative/policy/regulatory issues impact those specific drivers.
- Collaborate with fellow Policy/Advocacy Team members to share best practices, prioritize initiatives, and understand national and state level Medicaid/home care policy and initiatives.
- Collaborate with operating brand leaders to prioritize key initiatives.
- Collaborate with operating brand leaders and staff to develop relationships with key state legislators, Medicaid policy makers, other state regulatory policy makers, and payors to influence HCBS policy and elevate Hmong Home Health Care's brand in assigned states.
- Collaborate with operating brand leaders and staff to develop relationships with lobbyists, industry groups, home care providers, and other aligned interest groups to support issue advancement.
- Leverage state level relationships to influence Medicaid HCBS policy in key areas such as home care provider rates, employment policy, wage policy, Medicaid program policy and the overall HCBS policy environment.
- Prepare written and/or verbal testimony to inform legislators, governmental entities and other policy makers to influence positive impact to business interests.
- Identify new business, business partnerships, program changes that present new growth opportunities.
- Position reports to the Head of Advocacy and Policy

Position Qualifications:

 - 3+ years of city/state/county level legislative lobbying/engagement and/or working with key state level policy/decision makers to advance healthcare/Medicaid/or other policies.
 - A track record of tangible results from legislative and/or policy advancement.

 - Experience in healthcare, home care, or other related fields.
 - Established relationships with disability advocacy organizations.
